

Privacy policy

With this policy we explain the manner in which we may collect, use and disclose personal information which you provide us while using the danielnikolic.com website (hereinafter: the website) for the purchase of fitness workout programs and personal training.

The website is managed by the company FIT PLANET Ltd., Cesta v Pregavor 13, 6310 Izola, Slovenia. This policy has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation (EU) 2016/697 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on free movement of such data (hereinafter: General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR) and in accordance with the Slovenian legislation (mainly the Slovenian Personal Information Protection Act).

Personal data controller

The controller of the personal data is the company FIT PLANET Ltd., Cesta v Pregavor 13, 6310 Izola, Slovenia. The data subjects and other interested persons may contact the company by sending a letter to the company's headquarters via an email to info@danielnikolic.com.

Personal data

Personal data is information that identifies a person as a specific or an identifiable individual. An individual is identifiable when their identity can be directly or indirectly determined by indicating an identifier such as name, identification number, location data, web identifier, or by indicating one or more factors specific to the individual's physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity.

The provider collects and stores the following personal data, depending on the circumstances and for the purposes specified

below:

- 1) e-mail address;
- 2) selected password (data is encrypted);
- 3) date and time of registration and last login;
- 4) log files (IP address, access time, browser version).

FIT PLANET Ltd. does not allow logins to the website through third parties (Facebook, Google etc.).

How do we process your personal data?

Your data is processed with your explicit consent upon registration on the website. You give your explicit consent to the processing of your personal data on the website via a registration form by explicitly checking the “I agree with the Privacy and Personal Data Protection Policy and I expressly consent to the processing of the above personal data” box. You can revoke your explicit consent at any time (for more information, check the “Website users’ rights on their personal data” below).

The users of our services who are under the age of 16 may provide us their personal information only with the consent of their parents or legal guardians.

Who has access to your data?

Access to your data is provided to authorised staff according to the “need to know” principle. Such staff abide by statutory, and when required, additional confidentiality agreements.

We do not share your personal data with third parties and we do not export it to third countries.

How long do we keep your data?

The data from the first, second and third indents of the “Personal data” article (user name, email and password) is stored as long as the user account on the website is active (i.e. until the user

explicitly requests the deletion of the account).

Data usage

The data from the first, second and third indents of the “Personal data” article (email and password) is used to access and service the created account on the website.

Cookies

The website assigns a session cookie to the user upon registration, which maintains the user’s login status and checks the user’s existence with each request.

A cookie is absolutely necessary to provide an information society service - to ensure the operation of the website.

Website users’ rights on their personal data

The data subject has the following rights:

- 1) the right to revoke the consent: if personal data is stored and processed on the basis of the consent, the data subject has the right to revoke their consent. This does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing, which was carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation.
- 2) the right of personal data access: the data subject has the right to a copy of their personal data, which is stored and processed by the controller, and to certain information about the processing.
- 3) the right to rectify personal data: the controller corrects any inaccurate personal data without undue delay.
- 4) the right to erase personal data: the controller deletes all personal data upon request without undue delay; if the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected; if the data subject revokes the consent and there is

- no legal basis for further processing; or if the data subject objects to the processing and there is no other ground for a processing that would outweigh the right to object.
- 5) the right to data portability: the data subject has the right to transfer personal data to another controller, and the controller will not obstruct such transfer, meaning a direct transfer of personal data will be performed if that is technically feasible.
 - 6) the right to object to the processing.
 - 7) the right to file an appeal with the supervisory authority: the data subject has the right to appeal to the supervisory authority (to the Information Commissioner).

Security

In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure of the data obtained, to maintain the accuracy of personal data and to ensure its proper use, we use an appropriate technical and organizational procedures to secure the data we collect.

Payment options

There are two payment options on the website, via a proforma invoice or via a PayPal account.

Refunds

When buying any digital product or a training program on the website, you agree that a refund is not possible. This is because the content of the product is delivered immediately - it is sent to the customer and they can start using it immediately.

A refund is possible only in the following cases:

- in case of a technical problem; we acknowledge that the product has not been delivered to the customer.
- a bank or a PayPal account has been misused.
- the same order was inadvertently processed twice.

Liability notice

Consult your personal physician before starting any workout programs or diet plans that you have received through the website.

The information on the website is not intended to diagnose or treat any diseases or symptoms. You use all programs at your own risk. If you feel nauseous, dizzy, start vomiting or have chest pain consult your doctor.

It is possible that you feel muscle pain after starting new exercises or workout programs. If the muscle pain (muscle soreness) persist for more than 5-6 days, consult your doctor.
